CA STATEWIDE SPECIAL ELECTION: PROP 50

This year California held a statewide, special election for Proposition 50. Prop 50 was a ballot measure created in response to the gerrymandering by MAGA Republicans in Texas, who attempted to silence working-class voters and voters of color and ensure a win for Trump's Republicans in Congress in the 2026 midterms.

Prop 50 was California's chance to stand up to Trump's undemocratic power grab and stand with communities whose voices and votes are being silenced. And we did that! **Prop 50 overwhelmingly passed in California making this an important step against defending democracy, not only in California but across the country.** It won statewide by landslide at 63.9% - and San Francisco had the highest percent of YES votes than any other county in the whole state.

In partnership with California Calls Action, Seed the Vote Action Fund, Million Voters Action Fund, and Working Families Party, **we talked to 4,500+ voters on the phone** and at the doors to educate and inform them about why saying YES to Prop 50 was crucial. **We are deeply proud of our field team of 13 canvassers and 2 team leads** who called voters across the state, in blue, purple and red counties - and did not give up!

This win was a testament to California's fight against authoritarianism and the first step in holding Republicans and billionaires accountable!



SF RISING ACTION FUND: 2025 FALL MEMBER ASSEMBLY

This year we hosted a SF Rising Action Fund Fall Member Assembly to bring together our 6 caucuses: **Mujeres Trabajadores, Latinxs for Environmental Justice, Coleman Action Fund, Chinese Progressive Association Action Fund, Unidas En Accion, and Filipinx Progressive Caucus.**

During our Member Assemblies, we meet to build political power through political analysis and strategic discussion with our members. These meetings are a space where we make collective endorsements for ballot measures and candidates that align with our priorities and the needs of our communities.

In this year's Member Assembly, we reflected on our Prop 50 win, what that means for our communities, and what actions we can take in the next year to combat Trump's undemocratic attacks. We also looked ahead to upcoming 2026 local District Supervisor races in San Francisco and the open seat for the CA District 11 Congressional race.

We aim to hold elected officials accountable by bringing together working-class communities of color to the table of City Hall.
